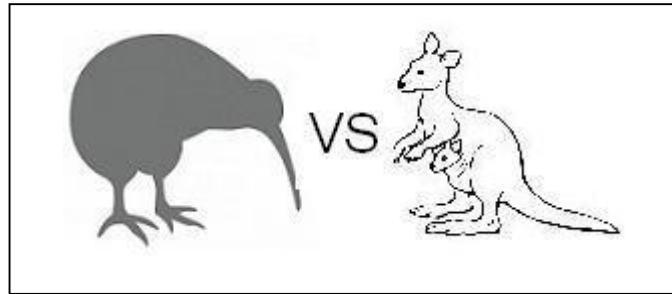


## New Zealand Reining Trans-Tasman Challenge



The 2020 Trans- Tasman competition is to be run within the rules & allowances of the New Zealand and Australian Governments travel permitting

Due to the challenges we are all faced with regarding Covid-19, both NZRHA & SCRHA would like to support this competition and encourages reiners to remain positive and work within the scope provided. To ensure the momentum and positivity of this competition remains we have/need to be open minded and remain flexible on how this maybe run.

We have a strategy plan with 3 options available to make sure there is some form of competition between the countries. They are as follows:

1. If travel is permitted - Travel to K Ranch, Sydney Australia and NZRHA compete against the Australian Trans-Tasman Team at the SCRHA Championships Show run 21st-26<sup>th</sup> September. However, competitors would require to be there earlier to get to know their horses and work with owners/trainers
2. If Travel is permitted but not before 2021 – We will look at the challenge to be held at a local/private venue (To keep costs down) Dates to be confirmed. It would be held between 1<sup>st</sup> Jan-March 2021 – Not to clash with NZRHA Nationals
3. Hold a virtual show. Sticking the same rules but competing in NZ on NZ Horses, being filmed and then sent to Australia to be judged by an NRHA Judge, should NZ Borders remain closed and/or with isolation periods required

Before applying please allow for flexibility with the changes & challenges that might arise, under these unusual times. While we continue to retain the traction this event has gained, we also ask that you accept full responsibility for your health prior to and during this event should travel be available into Australia

***We will be requiring a document to be signed before any travel out of NZ in that all responsibility is on each competitor and request that the appropriate Health Insurance be taken out.***
