### *NZRHA 2021 National Reining Show Rules*

**ENTRIES CLOSE: 24<sup>th</sup> MARCH 2021 – Full payment must accompany entry.**

Late entries after 24<sup>th</sup> of March will incur a \$20.00 late fee. (Anyone that has already entered prior to the entry closing date, and wishes to enter additional classes is not required to pay the late entry fee).

Refunds: Competitors must produce a vet or doctors' certificate within 7 days of the first day of the show to obtain a refund. In this instance, 75% of the total entry will be refunded.

Entry Form: Please use an official separate entry form (with all contact information given) for every horse/rider combination.

Numbers: NZWRF numbers to go on your entry form and horse numbers are to be worn. If your horse does not have an NZWRF number, please see the secretary on the morning of the show and you will be allocated a day number. You will not be able to enter the ring without a number.

Programme: The programme may change at the discretion of NZRHA.

Ribbons: Ribbons will be awarded to 6<sup>th</sup> Place. Sponsored prizes where available.

Prize Money / Buckles etc: To be eligible for any buckles and/or prize money etc, Riders must have been a current financial member of NZRHA prior to the 30<sup>th</sup> January 2021.

Horses that were born in the 2018 foaling season or later are not eligible to enter any NZRHA Shows for the 2020/2021 show season.

Where a class states 'to be ridden to the age of the horses', this is currently as per NZWRF guidelines.

All patterns ridden at the show are from the NRHA rule book. The NRHA patterns are available to download on the Patterns sections of our website: [www.reining.co.nz](http://www.reining.co.nz)

Where possible NZ Reining Horse Association uses the NRHA Handbook guidelines for our rules. These rules can be found on the NRHA website. However, there are instances where because of our unique reining environment this is not possible. In these cases, the NZRHA committee will apply a NZ ruling that benefits the sport of reining and the NZRHA members in a fair and considerate manner. This also means that occasionally we will apply a ruling made by NZWRF or similar governing body.

Arena: The arena will be available on Saturday morning 7am until 8:15am when it will need to be cleared for harrowing in preparation for an 8:30am start.

Rules for Arena Use: When the arena is open for practice and there are a number of riders, we will use a maneuverer system in 15-minute cycles. This means everybody does circles and spins, left circles must be done at the end you enter, right circles at the other end of the arena, spins to be worked on at the Centre of the circles. Next 15 minutes time slot is for the fencing/stopping only. Then back to circles and spins and so forth. This is the method used by Reining Australia and it works well for safety purposes. Circles at the hour and half hour. Stopping at the quarter past and quarter to on the clock.

### *NZRHA 2021 National Show Category Guidelines*

**ANY-HANDED CLASS** – Anybody can enter. To be judged you must stay on pattern, however you can ride one or two handed in the class and swap between one and two hands using any NRHA approved bit.

**NOVICE HORSE** – Horses that are in their first year of reining OR have NZRHA points of 25 or less. If you are unsure of your horses previous NZRHA reining recorded points please get in touch with the NZRHA Secretary. In this class horses MUST be ridden to their age according to NZWRF rules.

**GREEN RIDER** – For those new to reining/riding, or those who have 10 points or less, in any reining classes at any western performance show. In this class horses can be ridden 2 handed in a snaffle regardless of horse age.

**NOVICE RIDER** – For those with NZRHA points of 20 or less, in any reining classes at any western performance show. In this class horses can be ridden 2 handed in a snaffle regardless of horses' age.

**OPEN NOVICE RIDER** – For those with NZRHA points of 30 or less, in any reining classes at any western performance show. In this class horses MUST be ridden to their age according to NZWRF rules.

**NON-PRO** – Eligibility for NON-PRO this year will be if you hold a NZWRF Amateur Card. A photocopy of this is to be sent in with your entry please. In this class horses must be ridden one handed in a curb. On a case-to-case basis; if you do not hold an Amateur Card – but you own your horse and you DO NOT train or show astride horses for money, and you DO NOT take money for instruction on showing or training of a performance horses (Reining, Cutting, Cowhorse) then you may be allowed to enter Non-Pro. Any such requests for a Non-Pro card must be made in writing 2 weeks before entry closing date.

**PRIME TIME NON-PRO** – As above plus persons 50 years of age and older as at show day.

**OPEN FUTURITY** – 3- and 4-year-old horses are eligible. 3-year-olds may be ridden in a snaffle. A 4-year-old must be ridden one handed in a curb.

**NON-PRO FUTURITY** – Horses may be ridden in a snaffle in their 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> year as a NON-PRO ONLY.

### *NZRHA 2021 National Show Category Guidelines*

**5 YEARS & UNDER SNAFFLE BIT CLASS** – Open to horses 5 years old and under. In this class, horses must be ridden 2 handed in a legal snaffle bit. 5-year-old horses can enter both this class and the ‘Derby’ providing they follow bit requirements.

**DERBY CLASS** – Open to horses 5 – 8 years old. Horses must be ridden one handed in a curb.

**9 & Up** – Open to horses 9 years and older. Horses must be ridden one handed in a curb.

**OPEN** – Open to any horse and rider combination. In this class horses must be ridden one handed in a curb.

**FREESTYLE** – Only one horse allowed in the arena, props, costumes and music encouraged. Pattern must contain minimum mandatory requirements of 4 consecutive spins each way, 1 flying change from left to right, 1 flying change from right to left, 3 stops. Exhibitors can use two hands (as well as one or no hands) and any approved bit. There is a 4-minute time limit that includes any introductions. Music must be submitted with entry.

**RANCH RIDING** – AQHA patterns are used. Horses are classed per their NZRHA classification.

**NOVICE RIDER RANCH RIDING** – For riders to be eligible, they must hold a current NZWRF Novice Amateur card, or be classified as a rookie or a beginner rider. Riders are only able to enter ONE ranch riding event; either ‘Novice Ranch Riding’ or ‘Open Ranch Riding’ only. In this class horses can be ridden 2 handed in a snaffle regardless of horses’ age.

**‘STARSHIP HOSPITAL’ FUNDRAISER CLASS** – Ridden to age of horse. Competitors encouraged to ride in bright colours.

**INTER-ISLANDER CHALLENGE FINALE** – Ridden to age of horse. Eligible class for selected team members only. Each team member of both the North Island and South Island team are eligible to compete in this class for their final score run, in accordance with the Inter-Islander Challenge rules.
